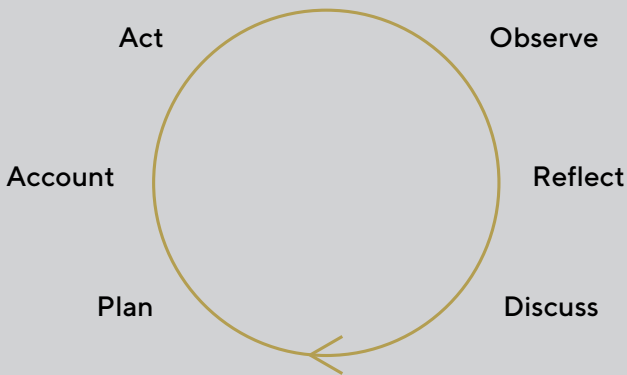
PRACTICING THE WAY OF JESUS

The Learning Circle

A simple visual tool to help disciples discuss and discern together how God may be speaking to us. Imagine the sorts of conversations Jesus would have had with his disciples in the gospels.

The ultimate aim is to answer two main questions:

1. How has God been speaking to us?
2. How is God's Spirit leading us in light of this reality?



Observe:

- What stood out for you in this passage/sermon?
- Is there anything you may have overlooked at first?
- What did you like/dislike or find comforting/encouraging?
- How did this passage/teaching make you feel towards God/yourself?

Reflect:

- What does this passage/sermon tell you about God/ourselves/the world?
- Is there anything that would hold you back from fully embracing this teaching?
- How do you think this teaching fits with your current understanding of the way things are?

Discuss:

- What would you say differently?
- What do you agree or disagree with most strongly?
- Why do you think that is?

Plan:

- What thread or theme do you need to hold on to today?
- How might you dwell on this or take this forward?

Account:

- Would you ask me about next time we meet?

Act:

- I think God's Spirit is leading me/us to
